# Madhya Pradesh CM serves defamation notice on Sonia

Madhya Pradesh Chief Minister Shriya Singh Chouhan on Monday served a ₹10 crore defamation notice on Congress Chief Sonia Gandhi and State Congress president Kanti Lal Bhatia. The defamation notice has been served on a Congress advertisement on corruption. The ad says, "A greedy family has looted Madhya Pradesh."



The Congress has been taking digs at Chouhan over alleged corruption in the recent past. The alleged defamatory publication in newspapers and internet via an advertisement accused the Chief Minister's family of keeping a currency counting machine at their official residence, purchase of dumpers and giving contracts to its laws, among others.

The notice asked the Congress to publish similar size ad in the same papers withdrawing the charges against the CM's family in a fortnight failing which the two threatened to file a ₹10 crore defamation suit. A notice has also been sent to the MPCC and its State president Kamal Bhatia stating that false statement advertisement published on the media on November 13, 2013 caused irreparable damage to reputation, trauma and agony to the CM and his wife. The Congress had placed

the advertisement in newspapers across the State that showed silhouette of a man and a woman and a heading on top saying, "Mukhya ke mish par tale, lakhi parner ne Madhya Pradesh ko loot dala." The chief has mouth shut while greedy family has looted Madhya Pradesh. It did not name the CM.

Besides the headline, objections have been raised on other points which reads, "Kyon zaron padni gane with machine ke?" (What was the need for a currency counting machine?). The many allusion resembled what a silhouette of Chouhan would look like. The defamatory publication was issued and published by the MPCC as per the declaration appearing on its right hand corner at the bottom. "Sonia Gandhi is of course in charge of and responsible for the overall loss of the Indian National Congress party across all States and Union territories of India," reads the notice issued by advocate
