Even as both the Houses of Andhra Pradesh Legislature remain paralysed for second consecutive day over Chief Minister N Kiran Kumar Reddy's notice to reject the State Reorganisation Bill, Speaker N Manohar summoned the Business Advisory Committee to take a call on the issue.

Both the Houses had to adjourn for the day without transacting any business as the protagonists of union, State and the supporters of Telangana State continued to clash verbally and shouted slogans against each other.

While the members from Secunderabad region wanted a resolution to be passed rejecting and returning the State Reorganisation Bill, members of Telangana region wanted the Chief Minister's notice to be rejected.

Two cops killed, five hurt in NDFB ambush

Another person, a police infanter was killed on the spot while five other police constables were injured during the incident, police said.
