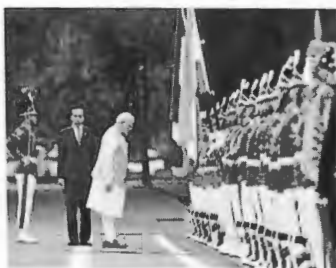
WORLD BEGINS INDONESIA VISIT
