

'NDA playing Cong-like vendetta politics'

Samajwadi Party supremo Maylaram Singh Yadav on Wednesday accused the BJP-led NDA Government of treating the footsteps of the Congress by unleashing the vendetta against its political opponents. Maylaram also declared that for the 2017 Assembly polls theedar (contractors) commission (corrupt) and dabang (bribe) will not be given the party ticket. The SP chief was addressing a meeting of the party cadre here to mark the 83rd birth anniversary of the socialist ideologue Janshwar Mishra better known as 'Chote Lohia'.

Maylaram's observations against the BJP assumes significance in the wake of the tightening of noose around the neck of Yadav Singh, the suspended chief engineer of NDA and his proximity with the top echelons of the ruling Samajwadi Party. The SP on Tuesday had conducted simultaneous rallies at 16 places of Yadav Singh, his

friends and relatives in Noida, Agra, Ferozabad and his IAS son-in-law residence in Lucknow.

"People were disillusioned with the Congress due to rampant corruption, raging inflation and growing unemployment during its regime and the BJP was quick to capitalise on the opportunity and was able

to capture power. The Congress framed all its political opponents in one case or the other. They framed me, Lala Prasad, Jayalalithaa and many others. The BJP is now following the footsteps of the Congress. I told a BJP leader that the Congress had a long stint in power but the BJP continues with its tirade

against its opponents then it stands to lose heavily and it will cut short its tenure in office at the Centre," said the SP chief.

Harking back to the Nehru era in public meetings, Yadav said, "Ram Manohar Lohia was the most vociferous critic of Jawaharlal Nehru, later Lohia was elected to continue with his campaign against Panditji and later his anti-Nehru stance in public meetings attracted huge crowds but the then Prime Minister took it in strides and never indulged in vendetta against his opponents." He added, "Lohia had challenged Nehru on the state of poverty in the country where 27 crore people or a family of five people survived on income of Rs 1 per day and Nehru accepted the fact."

Lamenting the abysmal tally of mere 5 MPs in Lok Sabha, Maylaram slammed his party leaders and cadre for their incompetence and lack of hard work for the poor show of the party during the May 2014 Parliamentary elections.

"Aapne hame kaheen ka nahi chanda (you have led me nowhere). Of the five MPs one is the wife of Akhilesh, two are his cousin brothers while one is his nephew. Despite the depleted strength the SP has been able to voice the grievances of the poor and downtrodden in a forceful manner," said the SP chief.

"I had you worked little harder and won the 30 Lok Sabha seats the Samajwadi Party would have been in power at the Centre today. This number of seats would have prevented the majority for the BJP and all parties would have rallied against it thus paving the way for the formation of non-BJP secular Government at the Centre," signed the SP chief.

Criticising his son for inaction he said, "I had asked the State party to give me a report ascertaining the causes of the poor performance of the party in 2014 Lok Sabha polls. I am still waiting for the report. Do not try to hide your failures and weakness, face it."

Sibal to fight for Madan Mitra in Saradha case

Murmur in Bengal Cong

A section of the Bengal Pradesh Congress leadership has expressed displeasure at the senior Congress leader Kapil Sibal's decision to argue the case of jailed Bengal Minister Madan Mitra.

Sibal arrived in Kolkata on Wednesday and was likely to appear in the Calcutta High Court for Mitra's prison case.

The Bengal Minister was arrested last year by the CBI. Earlier, repeated bail petitions filed by him had been rejected.

Opposing his bail plea the CBI counsel argued that the he being a powerful man may influence the case. In order to buttress its argument the CBI showed how Mitra had neither resigned his ministerial post nor had he

been removed by the Government. The Agency also showed how instead of being in jail Mitra had been put up in the VVIP Woodburn Ward of the SKKM Hospital, a State-run super-specialty unit, despite the fact that medical investigations on his health condition have revealed no significant condition.

While Sibal would not dwell much on his decision to stand for Mitra only saying he was a regular visitor to Kolkata for fighting cases, his Bengal party colleagues like PCC president Adhir Chowdhury tended to look a tad sore when he said, "we cannot say much about Mr Sibal's professional decisions."

He added "though as a professional Mr Sibal is free to voice for Madan Mitra's honesty as a party we will definitely face some embarrassment because he is also a senior leader of the

Congress Party. People may not take it kindly."

Privately the Congress leaders disapproved of Sibal's decision to contest Mitra's case as "in certain cases a political person you are expected to practice some kind of moral standard. In such cases you cannot say regate one's political identity from professional identity."

Last year the SC after hearing a petition filed by Pradesh Congress leader Abdul Mannan had ordered CBI investigation into the multi-crore case overruling the Trinamool Congress-run State Government's plea that the State was capable of investigating the scam. CPJM leader and former Kolkata Mayor Bikash Bhattacharya said, "as a professional I cannot comment on Sibal's decision. He must fit to do."

'Teesta, hubby made a business out of charity'

Affidavit filed in HC to oppose Teesta's plea to defreeze her bank accounts

Teesta Setalwad and her husband made a "business out of charity," said Ahmedabad Crime Branch in a fresh affidavit submitted to the Gujarat High Court. According to the affidavit, "not one penny" from cross of rupees raised out of art auctions and musical concert were disbursed among riot victims of 2002.

The affidavit was filed in order to oppose Teesta's plea to defreeze her bank accounts. The case was listed on Wednesday in the court of Justice Sonia Gokani. The Ahmedabad Police in its affidavit said that Teesta through her NGO Centre for Justice & Peace (CJP) organised musical concerts and art auctions and advertisements were made for raising the funds for the riot victims and even donations were sought for purchasing ambulances after 26/11 terror strike in Mumbai.

"In the case of an embellishment of funds for a museum at Golbarg society, damaged in the 2002 riots, Setalwad and her husband Javed Anand misappropriated funds for very per-



sonal nature including wine and whisky," said the affidavit.

The art auction was held in Mumbai in October 2008 and the total receipt from it was ₹1 crore. According to Teesta, ₹60 lakh was expenditure on the auction. However, police claimed that they did not furnish even one supporting voucher for the expenses claimed or the gross amount received.

"Assuming that petitioners are right, a net amount of ₹40 lakh was received by the (Setalwad) trust. Even out of this net amount of ₹40 lakh, an amount of ₹25 lakh was transferred to the CJP, leaving an amount of only ₹15 lakh out of the art proceeds with Setalwad," said police, adding that although the advertising blitzkrieg soliciting donation for riot victims had commenced, not one penny out of the art auction receipts was disbursed in any manner to or expended on the riot victims.

Jammu agitation over AIIMS suspended after demands met

AIIMS coordination on Wednesday evening decided to suspend its ongoing agitation behind the issue of setting up of separate AIIMS in Jammu after the Centre directed the State Government to identify pieces of land each to establish AIIMS in both the regions.

"It is good that the Centre has asked to identify 200 acres (1600 kanals) of land each in both the regions," Abhinav Sharma, Chairman, AIIMS Coordination Committee here told reporters.

He said that the Jammu bands will be called off from on Thursday but the ongoing chain hunger strike will continue unless a separate notification is issued by the Union Health Ministry on setting up AIIMS in Jammu region.

The announced following shortly after State Health Minister Choudhary Lal Singh told reporters at a separate Press briefing that the Government of India had asked the State Government to identify 200 acres of land each in both the regions for AIIMS.

"There was previously also no doubt on the issue of AIIMS for Jammu region but some members of Coordination Committee demanded it in black and white," Singh told reporters.

2002 HIT-AND-RUN CASE 'No direct evidence to show Salman was behind the wheel'

Contesting the prosecution's evidence that Salman Khan was behind the wheel at the time of the much-discussed September 28, 2002 mishap, his lawyer Anit Desai told the Bombay High Court on Wednesday that there was no witness or direct evidence to show that his client was driving the car at that time.

"There was no witness who had seen Salman Khan driving the car," the actor's lawyer Anit Desai told Justice A.B. Lokesh, who is hearing Salman's appeal against his conviction and five-year jail term in the 2002 hit and run case.

Desai also claimed that the trial court had also not taken into consideration the admission given by Ashok Singh, the actor's family driver, who had told the trial court on oath that it was he and not Salman who was driving the car at the time of mishap.

"Twenty-seven witnesses were examined by the trial court, but not of one them had said that Salman Khan was driving the car. Some witnesses said that he got down from the right side of the car, but that it so may mean that it was from the front seat," Desai said.



Rejecting the defence's request not to entertain the evidence of Ravindra Patil, the actor's police bodyguard who was also eye-witness and complainant in the case, on the ground that he was not available for cross-examination, Sessions Judge DW Deshpande had observed in his verdict delivered on May 6, 2015.

"But in my opinion, the evidence of Ravindra Patil is complete evidence. The facts depicted by him would not be changed, even the charge under section 304 Part II of the IPC is framed."

Patil, the actor's police body guard, had died of acute bilateral tuberculosis, at a city eye TB hospital on October 3, 2007, midway through the original trial. During the original trial, Patil had deposed before a Magistrate, saying that he had warned Salman not to drive rashly or else he would meet with an accident but the actor did not heed his advice.

Dismissing the argument made by the actor's lawyer that his client had been "implicated" by the police under media pressure, the judge observed that, "Such an argument also does not appeal to the conscience of the prudent man."

Udhampur attack leaves security agencies scratching their heads

Incident punches holes in Govt's tall claims of foolproof security

The terror strike along the Jammu-Srinagar National Highway on Wednesday has left behind a trail of puzzles for the security agencies as to why the incident occurred in the region in the run-up to the Independence Day celebrations, the security grid normally is reviewed on ground zero and its deployment meticulously.

This is so because the terror group which carried out the audacious strike on the BSF convoy pierced several rings of foolproof security before striking big and killing two BSF troopers on the most sensitive highway.

The fact that Northern command headquarters of the Indian Army was barely 15 kms away from the encounter strike raises many question marks. The intelligence agencies are focusing their energies to ascertain which route militants after sneaking inside the Indian territory took before reaching Srinagar.

The central agencies and local police are trying to untangle the mystery whether any local sleeper cell played any role and from where they collected weapons and grenades to launch a terror strike.

On the other hand, the claims made by the Pakistan national were yet to be verified by the central and local intelligence agencies but it also raises question marks on the tall claims of foolproof security along the highway at a time when Amarnath yatra is still going on and the same road was used by the Army and paramilitary convoys for ferrying their soldiers to and fro from Kashmir valley to Jammu.
