## 2020 riots: Umar, Imam playing victim card, Delhi Police tell SC

The Delhi Police on Thursday in the Supreme Court alleged that Umar Khalid, Sharjeel Imam, and others seeking bail in a UAPA case in connection with the 2020 Delhi riots were playing the "victim card" and seeking release on the ground of prolonged incarceration.

The police opposed bail to them and called Umar Khalid the chief conspirator behind the riots, and the one who had mentored Sharjeel Imam in planning the first phase of the violence. The riots were not spontaneous but part of

a "deep-rooted, premeditated and pre-planned" conspiracy, it claimed.

"The evidence gathered from the period preceding the execution of the conspiracy; documented communications, coordinated plans, and alignments between actors; establishes a clear meeting of minds," it said.

The material demonstrates not only knowledge but intention, revealing a deliberate design to bring the country into disrepute through targeted and strategic actions, it added. "It is submitted that it does not lie with the petitioners who were mala fide and mischievous

reasons have delayed the commencement of trial to come and play victim card and seek bail on the ground of prolonged incarceration.

"It is submitted that the conduct of the accused, apart from the irrefutable and ocular evidence available against them, disentitles them from seeking any relief of bail from this court," the law enforcement agency said in an affidavit filed in the top court.

Rebutting the argument that the trial is not likely to be completed due to 900 witnesses, the police said the statement was not only premature but also a "red

herring" manufactured to obtain bail. The police claimed that Khalid and Imam broke the "secular

fabric" of JNU and created a communal WhatsApp group, "Muslim Students of JNU", and also used students of Jamia

Milia Islamia to instigate and mobilise them.

"They started instigating students at Jamia and Shaheen Bagh. They adopted a model of *chakka-jam* in the name of protest and planned to convert it into disruptive *chakka-jam* at appropriate time, disruption of supplies and services essential to normal life and attempting to dismember constituent provinces of India from the Union of India," it said.

The motive behind the *chakka-jam* was killing and injuring police and "non-Muslims" on a mass scale through a communal riot, they claimed. "Imam under the

tutelage of Umar Khalid and other top conspirators conspired and engineered the first phase of the Delhi riots from December 13 to December 20, 2019. "Sharjeel Imam was instrumental in orchestrating the first phase of Delhi riots and the same could be established from Sharjeel Imam's chat," the police alleged.

They said that in January 2020, Khalid held a "secret meeting" in Seelampur with Gulfisha Fatima, Natasha Narwal, Devangana Kalita, and others, where he purportedly instructed them to induce local women of Seelampur to stockpile knives, bottles, acid, stones, chilli powder, and

other dangerous articles to engineer a riot. Fatima was accused in the affidavit of acting as a key coordinator who helped turn peaceful sit-ins into violent demonstrations, the police said.

Meeran Haider, a member of the Jamia Coordination Committee, was alleged to have overseen multiple all-day protest sites, collected funds, and encouraged protesters to attack police and non-Muslims, they said.

The bail pleas of Khalid, Imam, and others are scheduled to come up for hearing before a bench of Justices Aravind Kumar and NV Anjaria on Friday.

## Govt eases NOC norms for deregistered vehicles

In a major decision aimed at providing relief to lakhs of vehicle owners and furthering the cause of reducing vehicular pollution in the Capital, the Rekha Gupta Government on Thursday announced the relaxation of norms for issuing No Objection Certificates (NOCs) for deregistered vehicles.

It was decided to keep in abeyance the restrictive clause from the "Guidelines for Handling End of Life Vehicles in Public Places of Delhi, 2024" which limited the application for NOC to

only within one year of a vehicle's registration expiry.

This move will primarily benefit owners of diesel vehicles aged over 10 years and petrol vehicles over 15 years old, allowing them to obtain a NOC to re-register their vehicles in other States outside the Delhi-NCR region, irrespective of how long ago their vehicle's registration expired.

Speaking on the development, Transport Minister of Delhi, Pankaj Kumar Singh, said, "Our dual focus has always been on citizen welfare and environmental protection. We found that the one-year deadline for

NOC was creating an unintended logjam, leaving lakhs of vehicles stranded in Delhi.

These vehicles were neither being scrapped nor could they be moved out, leading to potential pollution and congestion. By relaxing this criteria, we are empowering our citizens to make a responsible choice. This decision will systematically phase out a significant number of older vehicles from Delhi's roads, giving a direct boost to our efforts in improving air quality and decongesting our city."

This proactive step, proposed in light of numerous public representations and

internal reviews, aligns with the department's earlier orders of 2021 and 2022, which were themselves formulated in compliance with the directions of the National Green Tribunal (NGT).

It ensures that vehicles deregistered due to age can be legally transferred to regions where they are permitted to ply, effectively removing them from the National Capital's ecosystem. The Government expects this notification to provide a structured and eco-friendly exit route for old vehicles, complementing the national vehicle scrapping policy and reinforcing Delhi's commitment to cleaner air.

## K-9 dog helps police unearth ₹1.2 crore drugs; 4 held

A K-9 unit dog of the Delhi Police helped officers recover 3.15 kg of *charas* worth around ₹1.2 crore in two separate operations. Four people, including a couple from Himachal Pradesh, have been arrested in connection with the cases, police said.

According to police, a team intercepted a car near Mukandpur Chowk on October 22 after a brief chase. Initially, a search of the vehicle yielded no visible illicit substance.

"However, when suspicions persisted, the team called in a K-9 unit for assistance. Police dog Amro detected a hidden cavity inside the vehicle, where 2.06 kg of high-quality contraband was found concealed. The specially-designed compartment had been created to evade detection," the police officer said. He added that the two persons in the vehicle — Chhuni Lal, a resident of Mandi in Himachal Pradesh, and his wife were arrested.

During interrogation, Chhuni Lal revealed that the contraband had been procured from Prakash Chand of Kullu in Himachal Pradesh.

Acting on the lead, the team arrested Chand on October 28, the police said, adding that Lal had earlier served a 10-year jail term in an NDPS case in Himachal Pradesh before resuming the illegal trade after his release in 2023.

Further investigation is underway to trace the larger supply network.

## Shankaracharya, Patel united India spiritually, politically: Bihar Governor

Bihar Governor Arif Mohammad Khan on Thursday drew a parallel between Shankaracharya and Sardar Vallabhbhai Patel, saying while one sought spiritual unity, the other strived for political unification. He was addressing a symposium at the Delhi Legislative Assembly ahead of the 150th birth anniversary of Sardar Vallabhbhai Patel on October 31.

"As Adi Shankaracharya established India's spiritual unity through Vedanta, Sardar Patel accomplished political unity through courage and conviction," he said at the symposium. Khan said true unity cannot be built on force or fear but must arise from shared emotion, consciousness, and purpose.

He described Patel's unification of more than 560 princely States as "a historic act of statesmanship — a task comparable to that of Bismarck in Germany, or

perhaps even greater". Applauding the Indian Governments' decision to commemorate Sardar Patel's birth anniversary as Rashtriya Ekta Diwas, he called it "a fitting tribute to the architect of India's unity".

"To fulfil the resolve of Prime Minister Narendra Modi to make India a developed and leading nation, we must constantly recall and reawaken the ideals and values for which Sardar Patel dedicated his entire life," the governor said.

Floral tributes were offered to the statue of Vithalbhai Patel in the presence of Delhi Assembly Speaker Vijender Gupta, Deputy Speaker Mohan Singh Bisht, Delhi Cabinet Minister Kapil Mishra, and Niranjanabhai Kalarthi, administrator of Swaraj Ashram, Bardoli (Gujarat), an official statement of Delhi Assembly Secretariat said.

Vithalbhai Patel was the Speaker-equivalent (president) of the British-era Central Legislative Assembly, a chamber of elected and

appointed Indian and British representatives with limited legislative powers. He was also the elder brother of Vallabhbhai Patel. A special exhibition showcasing rare archival photographs and historical documents tracing Sardar Patel's life and legacy was also inaugurated on the Assembly premises, according to the statement.

Gupta, in his address, said, "The strength of a nation lies not in its might, but in its unity of hearts and purpose".

He hailed Sardar Patel as the architect of India's integration, whose foresight and diplomacy transformed a divided land into one sovereign nation. "Sardar Patel's life reminds us that unity is not a slogan but a sacred duty," Gupta said, urging citizens to uphold the values of discipline, integrity, and selfless service that Patel embodied.

Kalarthi said Sardar Patel united 562 of 565 princely states "without letting a single drop of blood be shed." She described him as "a leader of deep compassion and humility" whose affection and foresight won the trust of rulers across India.

Kalarthi, the author of a book on Patel, is known to have been present at the Bardoli Satyagraha, a farmers' agitation and a nationalist movement from the late 1920s, which was led by Patel, among others.

Mishra said Patel's memory had been "immortalised through the Statue of Unity, which stands as a tribute to the nation's unifier". The event concluded with a collective pledge to uphold Patel's ideals, the statement said.

## Air quality turns very poor; AQI crosses 373 mark

Falling temperatures, persistent smog, and stagnant winds have combined to trap pollutants, pushing pollution levels to alarming highs as the air quality in Delhi deteriorated to the "very poor" category on Thursday after remaining "poor" for the past few days. The AQI stood at 373, categorised as very poor according to data from the Sameer application, which provides hourly updates published by the Central Pollution Control Board (CPCB).

A blanket of haze shrouded the national Capital on Thursday, with people complaining of eye irritation and cough, as air quality stood close to the "severe" level.

Experts blamed meteorological conditions that trap pollutants near the surface for the rise in the pollution level.

The India Meteorological Department (IMD) said the haze is expected to persist during early morning and late evening hours through the week, as particulate

matter continues to accumulate near ground level.

Delhi, which has been witnessing a fall in air quality since Diwali, recorded 'very poor' air quality with an AQI of 373, a sharp rise from 279 a day earlier. Smog significantly reduced visibility, with the CPCB recording PM 2.5

levels at 184.4 and PM 10 at 301.9. Vivek Vihar (426), Anand Vihar (415), Ashok Vihar (414), Bawana (411), Wazirpur (419) and Sonia Vihar (406) saw "severe" category air quality.

In the NCR region, Noida recorded an AQI of 372, Ghaziabad 364, Greater Noida 330, Gurugram 248 and Faridabad 166. Experts said the yellowish smoke enveloping the city is smog — a mixture of fog and pollutants that reduces visibility and poses serious health risks, especially for vulnerable groups. The Air Quality Early Warning System for Delhi reported that the city's ventilation index — a measure of the atmosphere's ability to disperse pollutants — remained below the favourable level of 6,000 m<sup>2</sup>/s.
